There will be 2 sessions for each community Centre

You will need to book a time to attend the clinic – please bring medicare card with you

WHEN YOU ATTEND THE CLINIC:

- ➤ If you are travelling by car, you must stay in your car and only 1 person will let the clinic staff know you have arrived and collect consent forms staff will then advise when to line up
- ➤ If you are catching public transport or walking you will need to follow the signs outside of the clinic and let clinic staff know when you have arrived so they can show you where to line up and give you a consent form.

SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST DO'S

- > Elders should only travel and attend clinic with 1 other adult
- Families must not mix together at the clinics
- ➤ You must not stand in a group stay with just your family household there needs to be 1.5 metre distance between all families you will need to follow the signs and instructions given to you by the clinic staff to ensure the safety of everyone.
- After your flu shot you will need to wait around for 15 minutes in the waiting area and then afterwards return straight back to your home.

This is not a social gathering – we need to keep our mob safe

Do not come to the clinic if you are sick with cold or flu symptoms

Do not come to the clinic if you have travelled overseas in past 2 weeks

Do not come to the clinic if you have been in contact with someone who is sick
