Are you an Allied Health student interested in a unique remote and rural health or community placement?

The WA Centre for Rural Health (WACRH) offers students and universities the opportunity for final year clinical placements focused on aged care in remote and rural settings. Placements are based on Yinggarda Country in Carnarvon in the Gascoyne region of WA.

You will complete your placement across aged care settings in the Carnarvon community and work with other allied health and nursing students.

Timetables and placement dates can be adjusted to meet university commitments.

You will stay in our comfortable and secure accommodation and will have access to shared vehicles for work and limited recreation use.

Accommodation and travel scholarships are available to eligible students.

You will be supervised by a clinician in your own profession and be supported by our WACRH Interprofessional Allied Health academic staff. What's in it for you – Placement outcomes:

- Work with students and professionals from a range of disciplines and develop skills in interprofessional practice.
- Participate in community programs providing services that are valued and much needed in remote and rural communities.
- Apply your professional scope of practice in a culturally responsive way.
- Experience different clinical, project and community-based environments in remote and rural aged care settings.
- Increase your confidence in remote and rural practice whilst achieving your university placement requirements.
