Calling for Nominations for Director Candidates for the board of IAHA

There are **4 Director (Graduate) positions to be filled** at the 2023 AGM elections. Candidates may include existing Directors who nominate for re-election and any Full Members (Graduate) who nominate.

To be eligible to be appointed as a Director you must be an IAHA Allied Health Graduate Full Member and must not be an employee of IAHA or IAHA NT

As Members nominate, their details will be posted to the Members only section of IAHA's website with the AGM papers and relevant documents.

Director candidates are invited to provide a recorded video or written statement, presenting their case for election, to be posted on the Members'-only section of IAHA's website. The recording may be up to 5 minutes.

IAHA will provide mentoring and coaching for candidates in preparing and presenting the recorded video or written statements. Candidates who wish to access this service should contact IAHA on the details set out below.

ATTACHMENT 2

Calling for Nominations for Director Candidates for the board of the NT Subsidiary

There are **3 Elected Director position to be filled** on the board of the NT Subsidiary.

To be eligible for appointment by the IAHA Members, you must:

- be at least 18 years old;
- be an IAHA Allied Health Graduate Full Member;
- reside in the Northern Territory, or have a cultural kinship and connection to Country in the Northern Territory (supported by a letter of support from a relevant nation group or community elder); and
- not be an employee of IAHA or IAHA NT.

As Members nominate, their details will be posted to the Members only section of IAHA's website with the AGM papers and relevant documents.

Director candidates are invited to provide a recorded video or written statement, presenting their case for election, to be posted on the Members'-only section of IAHA's website. The recording may be up to 5 minutes.

IAHA will provide mentoring and coaching for candidates in preparing and presenting the recorded video or written statements. Candidates who wish to access this service should contact IAHA on the details set out below.
