- Subsidised, shared, student accommodation for domestic students (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students are prioritised)
- Support and teaching from senior Yolnu educators and Elders
- Student Networking and Interprofessional Sessions (SNIPS). Community based placement visiting Yirrkala, Gunyangara and nearby Homelands
- Access to local support staff, Wi-Fi, computers, meeting rooms and study areas

- Campus site based in the township of Nhulunbuy
- Opportunities to explore beautiful Arnhem Land, and its rich culture
