We offer:

- Introductory sessions to local cultural contexts
- Contemporary, subsidised, shared, student accommodation for domestic students (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students are prioritised)
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander staff members, or Elders at most campuses
- Student Networking and Interprofessional Sessions (SNIPS)

- Access to local support staff, Wi-Fi, computers, meeting rooms and study areas
- Campus sites in Darwin, Katherine, Alice Springs, Tennant Creek, and Nhulunbuy

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students can also get placement support from:

- Congress of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Nurses and Midwives (CATSINaM)
- Indigenous Allied Health Australia (very active in the NT)
