Notice of member's rights in connection with receiving documents

IAHA and IAHA NT give notice under section 110K of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) of the rights of members to:

- elect to receive or not receive certain documents; and
- make requests to receive certain documents in physical or electronic form.

IAHA and IAHA NT's standard practice is to send communications to its members electronically to ensure that you stay informed and to reflect our continued commitment to reducing paper usage.

Documents

IAHA and IAHA NT are required to send the following documents to their members, and their members are entitled to receive:

- documents that relate to the meetings of the members of the company (such as notice of a meeting or proxy or voting forms);
- the Annual Report (comprising the financial report, director's report and auditor's report for the relevant financial year); and
- other documents prescribed by the relevant regulations,

collectively, the 'Documents'.

Members rights

Each member is entitled to elect, by notifying IAHA (whether or not in writing) whether they would like to receive:

- the Documents in physical form or electronic form; and
- all Documents or specific Documents.
