## Terms and Conditions: IAHA Members Professional Development Scholarship for Leadership Program Alumni

The Scholarship recipient agrees:

- a) I have read and will abide by the IAHA Code of Conduct and relevant policies and procedures in relation to travel and finance.
- b) That the scholarship will be used only in accordance to the recipients' application description.
- c) That the scholarship will fund the recipient's conference registration, flights from the closest airport, and accommodation. All other incidentals will be self-funded by the recipient (e.g. meals, parking, airport transfers, etc.0
- d) That I am able to self-fund for other incidental costs incurred through my participation and which are not included within the scholarship opportunity.
- e) I understand and agree that the opportunity may require shared accommodation.
- f) To reimburse IAHA in the event of any last-minute airfare and/or accommodation changes or cancellations.
- g) To submit to IAHA, a detailed written reflection report on my attendance, experience and learnings no later than 4 weeks following completion of professional development opportunity.
- h) To submit to IAHA an acquittal of funds related to the professional development opportunity, no later than 4 weeks following completion of the intended opportunity (where applicable).
- i) To attend and actively engage in the professional development opportunity. Failure to attend will result in ineligibility for future scholarships and full recovery of funds.
